Resurfacing & Restriping

- 2016 Program
 - Total project funding: \$3.26 Million for 20.2 miles
 - o Resurfacing completed in Summer and Striping in Fall
 - Key Corridors completed:
 - Flat Shoals Road
 - Stonewall Tell Road
 - West Stubbs Road
 - Yates Road
- 2017 Program
 - Anticipated funding: \$1.41 Million for 13.1 miles
 - o Project to be start in Spring 2017
 - Key Corridors proposed include
 - Burdett Road
 - Clark Road
 - Ridge Road
 - Thaxton Road
 - Washington Road
 - West Road

Sidewalk Projects

- Campbellton Road
 - Contractor issued final punch list on October 4th
 - o Contractor is expected to be completed by mid-November
- Old National Highway Phase 1
 - o Contractor to start in January 2017
 - Should be completed in Fourteen (14) months
- Other 2017 Proposed Sidewalk Projects (pending 2017 budget)
 - o Union Road between Westlake HS and Campbellton Road
 - Creel Road between Old National Hwy and Rocky Springs Court
 - Old Fairburn Road between Camp Creek Pkwy and Thaxton Road
 - Welcome All Road between Roosevelt Hwy and City of East Point
