#### I. Project Description

In 2006, the Department of Health & Wellness conducted the "Adamsville Area Demographics and Health Study", released in 2009 related to a (proposed) expansion of the Adamsville Health Center located at 3700 M.L.K. Jr Dr. SW, Atlanta, GA 30331.

#### II. The Service Area

The Southern boundary extends from Campbellton Rd. to Cobb County line; Bolton Road at Peyton Road continuing along Perry Boulevard in the Northeast, Mildred Place and West Lake Avenue. Located within five (5) miles of the Center, approximately 95% of the Center's clients were residents in these areas.

### III. Demographic Data

95% of the residents are African-American, 28% are below 18 yrs., 15% are over 65, 56% female, 29% high school graduates, 24% 2 years college or more.

## IV. Findings

The Adamsville Area, "Central and South Fulton" had a higher percent of deaths than the rest of Fulton County by the following medical conditions:

- Major Cardiovascular Disease (MCD)
- Hypertension
- Stroke
- Cancers
- Asthma- Hospital Discharges

#### V. <u>Updates of Adamsville Area Health Status Study</u>

#### A. <u>2013 Update</u>

A review of the 2006 Findings for the period 2011-2013 referred to as the "2013 Update" did not indicate a significant change in the 2006 health status data. Certain census tracts within Central and South Fulton had a higher percent of deaths by MCD, Hypertension, Cancers, and Asthma Hospital Discharges than the rest of Fulton County.

#### **B.** 2016 Update

The "2016 Update" for the period 2014-2016 indicated Central and South Fulton had a higher percent of deaths by MCD, Hypertension, and Asthma Hospital Discharges than the rest of Fulton County.

However, the "2016 Update" indicated the "Morgan Falls community", City of Sandy Springs, North Fulton had a higher percent (rate) of deaths by "All Cancers" than the rest of Fulton County.

The "Morgan Falls community" is <u>44%</u> African American and <u>13%</u> Hispanic. The Median Household Income is <u>\$50,780</u> and the Per Capita Income is <u>\$32,279</u>. <u>97%</u> of residents are High School Graduates and <u>48%</u> have Bachelor's Degrees.
