## **Residents Invited to Give Input on Central Library at June 14 Meeting**

Fulton County residents are invited to give input on the future of the Fulton County Library System's Central Library. A public meeting is being held Tuesday, June 14, 7 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. on the Main floor of the Central Library, at 1 Margaret Mitchell Square, Atlanta, GA 30303.

At its May 18 meeting, the Board of Commissioners discussed options for the Central Library. Those options include either renovating the current facility or constructing a new library at a different location in the downtown area.

This discussion comes as the Atlanta-Fulton Public Library System enters the second phase of a \$275 million building program, funded by a Library Bond Referendum approved by Fulton County voters in 2008.

Phase I of the Capital Program included the construction of eight new branch libraries and major renovation to two libraries. Seven of the new libraries are now open, with the eighth (Southeast Library) scheduled to open next month.

**The Phase I South Fulton Library is scheduled to open September 2016.**

Phase II will include construction or renovation of the Central Library, as well as renovation of other branches throughout the system.

The following requests were denied: 16-0453 College Park; 16-0454 City of Atlanta, Martins Park; 16-0461 City of Atlanta, Cascade Falls. The remaining requests were HELD pending the receipt and review of impact data by the P&CD Department. The final vote by the Board of Commissioners regarding the subject requests has been scheduled for the June 15 Recess Meeting of the Board of Commissioners.

## **USE PERMITS ZONING MODIFICATIONS APPLICATIONS**

### **West Stubbs Road (Hampton Oaks Subdivision) D. R. Horton, Developer**

Request to modify nine (9) conditions related to the original zoning. Staff Recommendation for DEFERRAL up to 60 Days APPROVED to deal with gas pipeline on the property.

### **7295 Connell Road (Deerwood Park Subdivision)**

Use Permit for group residence: six (6) children in an existing structure. Staff and Community Zoning Board (CZB) recommendation to DENY approved.

Request to reduce minimum lot width at the building line APPROVED. Building permits had been issued for dwellings on both sides of the subject two lots; applicant unable to add property to meet the requirements
